These roadblocks stand in the way of progress during the most important developmental windows.

By choosing a cash-pay model, **we remove those barriers and keep the focus where it belongs—on helping your child grow, communicate, and thrive.** This approach allows us to offer flexible scheduling, intensive programs when needed, and personalized therapy plans guided only by evidence-based practice and your family's goals. **We also provide superbills so families can submit for out-of-network reimbursement, while ensuring that your child's care is never dictated by red tape.**

Assessments & Evaluations

Feeding & Swallowing Assessment

\$400

- Comprehensive clinical evaluation covering oral-motor skills, sensory responses, posture, and mealtime observation.
- Review of medical and feeding history to identify underlying concerns and risk factors.
- Parent consultation to discuss findings, answer questions, and outline therapy options.
- Includes a detailed written report with assessment results, recommendations, and next steps for home, therapy, and medical providers.

Review of Instrumental Assessment

\$300

- Thorough review of Videofluoroscopic Swallow Studies (VFSS) or Fiberoptic Endoscopic Evaluation of Swallowing (FEES) reports.
- Requires access to the raw footage of the instrumental assessment for accurate analysis.
- Includes consultation with the family and collaboration with the SLP/medical provider who conducted the study.
- Provides a comprehensive written summary and recommendations to guide safe swallowing and feeding strategies at home and in therapy.

Parent Coaching 12 week (2x/week)

\$3600

- 12-week, 24-session program focused on parent coaching for feeding success at home.
- Step-by-step guidance in mealtime strategies, sensory supports, and behavioral tools.
- Training in safe feeding practices tailored to your child's unique needs.
- Ideal when direct child therapy isn't required, but families need expert support to make daily meals less stressful and more successful.

Our Intensive Sessions

Intensive therapy jumpstarts progress by providing frequent, focused sessions during the most important learning windows. With 3–5 sessions each week, paired with parent coaching, children build skills faster and families gain tools they can use every day—making it an empowering way to begin your therapy journey.



4-Week Intensive (3 sessions/week)
Total: \$2400

6-Week Intensive (4 Sessions/ week)

8- Week Intensive (5 sessions/ week)
